The case has now been handed over to the Prosecutor General and the reasons are considered: Your registration information is considered to be so generally held that it cannot form the basis for an examination of the prerequisites for initiating a preliminary investigation. The Prosecutor General can therefore not take any action on the grounds of the notification.

Then under the heading "information" indicates. Issues regarding crimes in the service of the Cabinet are being examined by the Parliament's Constitutional Committee (KU). This means that KU can initiate a preliminary investigation of such a crime. Anyone who can reasonably believe that a government minister can be suspected of a breach of duty can therefore report the matter to KU.

My report is hardly generally held when I named everyone within the government, I have stated the date when the crime was committed and I have also referred to what legislation and which paragraphs I open calls and why I believe they have committed a crime.

Then, as a private person, I get the impression that I cannot report to KU. So I turn to Parliamentary Ombudsman (JO) instead and my application there is registered on 19.12 and gets diary number 9196-2019. JO, or the parliamentary ombudsmen who work according to the laws and regulations governing their work. ... and more than the Constitution can hardly be?

On 27 December, I receive a response from JO, who writes the following: JO's main task is to check that authorities follow the laws and regulations governing their work.

However, the Government and the Minister are not under the supervision of JO as stated in §2 3 paragraph 4 that the Act (1986: 765)

The Ombudsmen's supervision does not include ... the government or ministers

Thus, JO cannot take up your case.

So the prosecutor is not entitled to apply if the government has broken the law, JO does not want to take the matter and KU is only for the members of parliament to turn to.

A Constitutional Court is a state institution for so-called norm control, that is, it has the function of checking whether laws contravene the Constitution and thus declare them invalid. It is not about politics. It only guarantees that what has been so important that the politicians have written it into the Constitution is interpreted consistently over time. Sweden has no direct counterpart - the government's proposals, and their conformity with the laws, are tested instead by the Law Council, which, however, has no review mandate. In addition, all Swedish courts have the right to trial.

And this is where we stand today without a normal platform to put the Riksdag and the government in charge of their actions towards the people.

The official's responsibility was abolished in 1974

Until then, errors or omissions in the service could lead to those responsible being convicted of service errors. The scale of the sentence ranged from fine all the way to prison. In addition, there was the opportunity to suspend the official from further work, or even dismiss the person concerned.

Violence monopoly is a political science and philosophical term that describes the modern state's exclusive right to use force in its territory. One can say that the monopoly of violence and a bounded territory are two characteristics that distinguish the state from other organizations in a society.

This exclusive right is exercised under the laws of some limited authorities (military, police, etc.). Thus, in a rule of law, the monopoly of violence is exercised under the laws and with guarantees that the monopoly should not be abused. In practice, the monopoly of violence in modern democracies is usually expressed through other forms of coercive means than direct physical violence, such as the imprisonment of imprisonment and the determination of ownership in disputes. Institutions such as criminal justice and the prosecuting authorities, which forcibly enforce court decisions, are seen as parts of the monopoly of violence.

Violence monopoly is generally one of the basic prerequisites for a state to be recognized as a sovereign state by other countries. It is a matter of course that in a democracy and the rule of law, the monopoly of violence must be exercised under the laws otherwise there would be anarchy. And this is where we approach the question of whether the people can go beyond the written laws and use violence themselves in any situation. I think that in this situation Sweden is in today because the government is unable to protect the people. Therefore, we must dare to address the issue of armed struggle so as not to be annihilated as some ethnic groups were exposed 70 years ago.



Government formation in Sweden after the 2018 elections

Government formation in Sweden after the 2018 election took 129 days of probation and government negotiations, compared with the previous Swedish record of 25 days after the elections in 1979. However, government formation was not remarkably long in comparison with Europe's most long-standing expedition governments. The Government Löfven I acted as transitional government pending the formation of the government.

The January agreement was concluded or the four-party agreement was entered into between the Social Democrats, the Environment Party, the Center and the Liberals, and tolerated by the Left Party, the Löfven II Government (Social Democrats and the Environment Party) could finally take office on January 21, 2019.

All this, just to exclude the Sweden Democrats, or 1.1 million votes from making their voices heard.

As a consequence, the Alliance was declared dissolved at the national level by representatives of the incoming parties.

The Alliance was then disbanded by, among others, Ebba Bush Thor (KD) and Ulf Kristersson (M). Instead, the Liberals and the Center Party believe that the Alliance died already before Christmas 2018, when Ulf Kristersson chose to go forward as his own government alternative with the Christian Democrats, against the will of his fellow Alliance comrades. Annie Lööf (C) also believes that the Alliance's death began when Anna Kinberg Batra (M) in January 2017 declared that the Moderates wanted to break the isolation of the Sweden Democrats, even though the Liberals and the Center Party had a different view.

Swedish Migration Agency (Migrationsverket)

Autumn 2015 will forever be historic for the Swedish Migration Board. We have never had as much to do as we had then. For those of you who don't know, almost 163,000 asylum seekers came.

1. "People who came here and who went home as soon as they got permission with our contributions intact."

"And even without a residence permit, you can run a business, pay taxes and get a salary. You will then need to be assigned a coordination number by an authority. In that process, no one checks your true identity."


Sweden today signed the UN Global Compact Migration Agreement in Morocco on December 10, 2018




Above is a demographic calculation of population exchange with Muslims in 2028. The redder the greater the proportion.

Summary:

In addition, the statutory "equality principle" has been put into play by newcomers' right to pre-emption, in both the housing market and tax-subsidized employment.

Therefore, the undersigned appeals for support for this appeal by the Swedish people, as a basis for prosecution with legal action pursuant to Article 3 of the "Genocide Commission for Crime" for the party leaders Stefan Löfven and Fredrik Reinfeldt together with their governments under Law (2014: 406).

Today's legal system with removed official responsibility means that the people must move on to higher instance.

These two party leaders, along with their governments, are to be prosecuted for genocide, crimes against humanity and war crimes in accordance with Law (2014: 406). But since we have a judicial system that does not work, and also a Constitutional Court to turn to, the people in Sweden turn to The Al Organization with our request.

We refer to the following articles

Article III

The following acts shall be punishable:

- (a) Genocide;
- (b) Conspiracy to commit genocide;
- (c) Direct and public incitement to commit genocide;
- (d) Attempt to commit genocide;
- (e) Complicity in genocide.

Article IV

Persons committing genocide or any of the other acts enumerated in article III shall be punished, whether they are constitutionally responsible rulers, public officials or private individuals.
